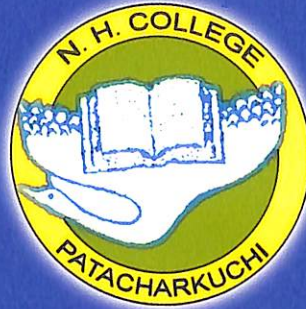

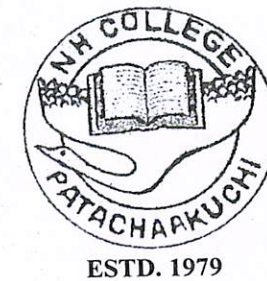

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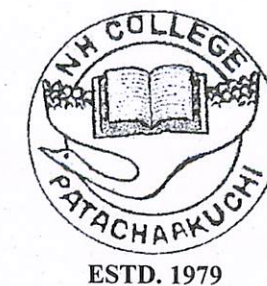
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From The Editorial Desk

National Knowledge Commission



The national knowledge commission (NKC) was constituted on 13th June, 2005. The NKC is the out come of the high level Advisory body to the Prime Minister of India with a mandate to guide policy and direct reforms. The commission was set up mainly to full fill the aspiration of higher education. National knowledge commission has made a significant

contribution to built excellence in the educational system to meet the knowledge challenges of the 21st Century and India's competitive advantage in fills of knowledge. NKC has made a contribution to promote creation of knowledge in science and technology laboratories and improve the management of institutions engaged in intellectual property rights. In the words of NKC - we recognize that a meaningful reform of the higher education system, with a long-term perspective is both complex and difficult. Yet, it is imperative. And we would suggest the following building blocks in this endeavour. First, it is essential to reform existing Public Universities and undergraduate colleges. Second, it is necessary to overhaul the entire regulatory structure governing higher education. Third, every possible source of financing investment in higher education needs to be explored. Fourth, it is important to think about to-active strategies for enhancement of quality in higher education. Fifth, the time has come to create new institutions in the form of National Universities that would become role models as centers of academic excellence. Sixth, the higher education system must be so designed that it provides access to marginalized and excluded ground. NKC also recommends the creation of 50 National Universities that can provide higher education. NKC also proposes a transition to a course credit system where degree are granted on the basis of completing a requisite number of credits from different courses, which provides students with choices. National knowledge Commission (NKC) recommends a clear need to establish an INDEPENDENT REGULATORY AUTHORITY for HIGHR EDUCATION (IRAHE). Thus the NKC has strongly advocated for a change in the system of regulation for higher education. In the words of the NKC - "It is important to recognize that there is a quite crisis in higher education in India which runs deep." NKC's recommendations constitute an important era for higher education

Report From the Women Forum

Awareness Programme on Increasing Violence against women and Children and our Responsibility

N. H. College Women Forum organized an awareness programme on "Increasing Violence against women and Children and our Responsibility" on the 15th of May, 2013. The awareness programme commenced with a chorus "Jilikaba Luitore Par". The meeting is presided over by Dr. Bhupesh Sarma, Principal, N. H. College, Patacharkuchi. The purpose of the meeting is explained by Kalyani Devi, Secretary, Women Forum, N. H. College, Patacharkuchi. The chief guest Headmistress of the 1042 No. Sariha Satra Primary School laid stress on the continued violence against women. Then another chief guest of the meeting Mrs. Bhabani Haloi dealt at length with the violence against women at Women's health (malnutrition). She referred to a news published in "The Dainik Assam" dated May' 13, 2013. Another chief guest of the meeting Mayarani Das referring to the Delhi gang rap victim Damini. Mrs Das discussed at length the issue of violence against women and children. Renu Devi, Assistant Teacher of the school speak about the long-seated problems. Dr. Nabanita Kalita, Assistant Professor, Department of Assamese, N. H. College and a prominent member of Women Forum recite a poem named "Sonjira Mahi". Renu Barman eminent literature in her speech informed the house that one out of two children is molested. According to UNO report about 53% children have been victims. She referred to the audience that even before pregnancy violence against women start. Mrs. Barman talked about economic freedom which is the root cause of violence against women. She also talked about women's property rights. She emphasized that there should be joint/common property rights among men and women. She expressed her concern over the alarming misproportion between men and women in some state like U.P., Haryana, Madhya Pradesh where female proportion per thousand is 500 against 1000 male population. Senior Citizen, Arbinda Goswami, stressed the need for allopathic science for the cure of diseases like small pox. He laid emphasis of locally available fruits and vegetables by pregnant women instead of imported fruits, vegetable etc. Dr. P. C. Goswami, Associate Professor, N. H. College laid emphasis on the role of parents in the education



of children. He also talked about the significance and value of moral education, Referring to the vedic Age, Dr. Goswami established that the women have been held in high esteem since Pre-historic time. Another speaker Pratibha Devi stressed the need for awareness among women in the Pre-natal stage women should be aware of their children and make them aware of their education, role as well. Dr. Bhupesh Sarmah raised objection against the view that in Gita women have been held in high esteem. He differed with the house in the context of unruly character among youths. Dr. Sarmah stressed that women must struggle against their exploitation. Binima Patgiri of Sankrit Department offered vote of thanks.

Gauhati University Institute of Distance and Open Learning (IDOL) N. H. College Study Centre

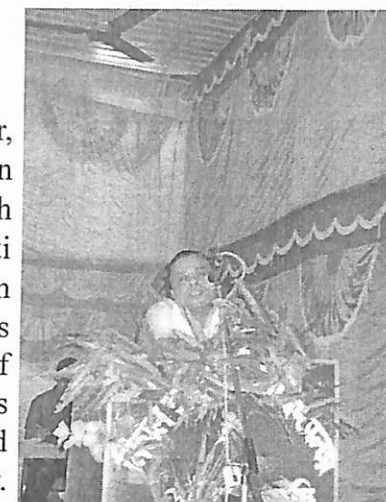

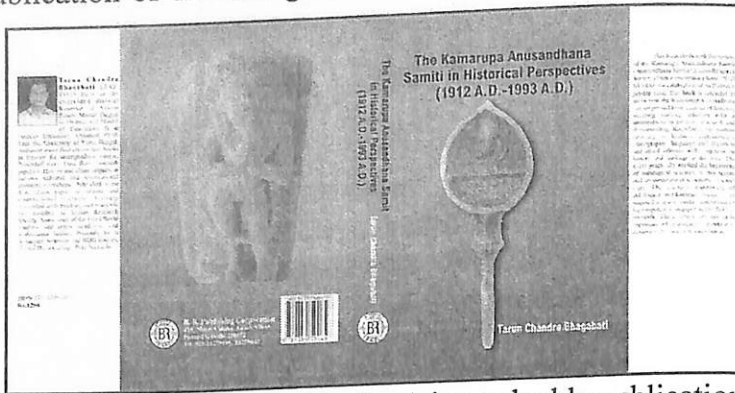
BLOOM 'N' SHINE

Annual Conference of ACTA, Barpeta Zone

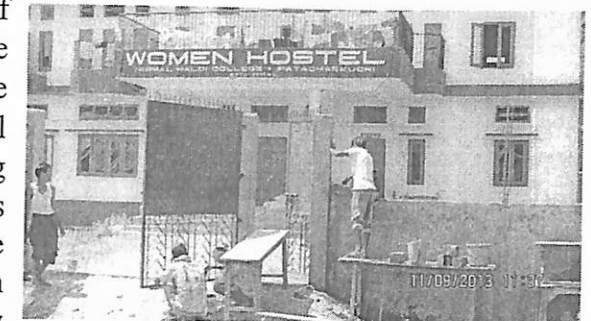

WOMEN HOSTEL

H. college authority has applied for grant under the scheme of construction of women hostel of University Grant Commission during 11th plan and Rs.4000000/- was sanctioned by UGC. With this grant the college has constructed a beautiful women hostel which is a milestone in the history of N. H. College. The hostel has been formally inaugurated by Dr. Jogen Ch. Kalita, Director of college development council, Gauhati University and boarders are now living there.



➤ Administration is the key to academic activities. With this sense an Administrative Block including the Principal's chamber, Office room, and confidential room has been established within the existing structure with the addition of modern sanitation. The infrastructure of the college office has been modernized so as to facilitate the non-teaching staff to work with satisfaction.

➤ The construction of Students' Day Home has been completed and made open for the students.

➤ Independent teachers' common room for three departments have been newly constructed and allotted to Political Science, Philosophy and Assamese department.

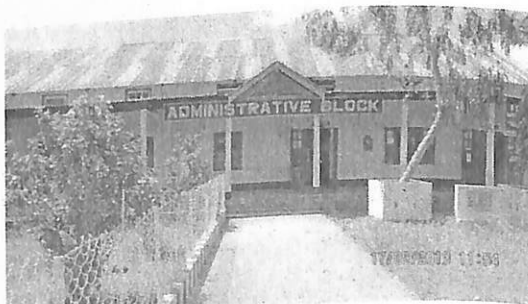
➤ A toilet block for gents is constructed with all modern facilities and made open for the students.

➤ Library is the most important part of a college. The library building has been extended so as to accommodate for more books. All the preparations for introducing token counter in library has been completed and the students will be able to avail that facility from the coming academic session. The bamboo ceiling over the library and reading room has been replaced by e-board.

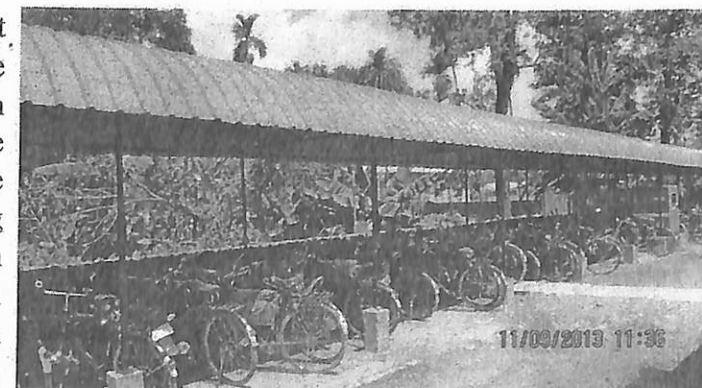
➤ A conference hall cum teachers' common room with computer has been established.

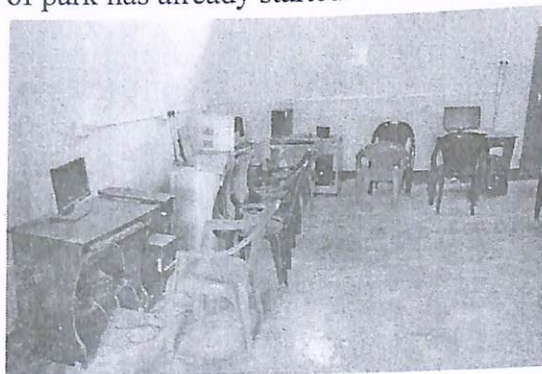
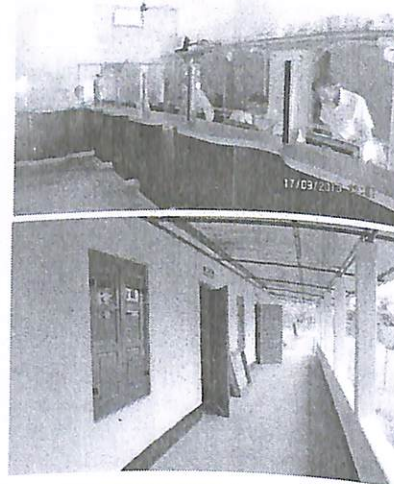
➤ For round O' clock power supply digital generator has been installed.

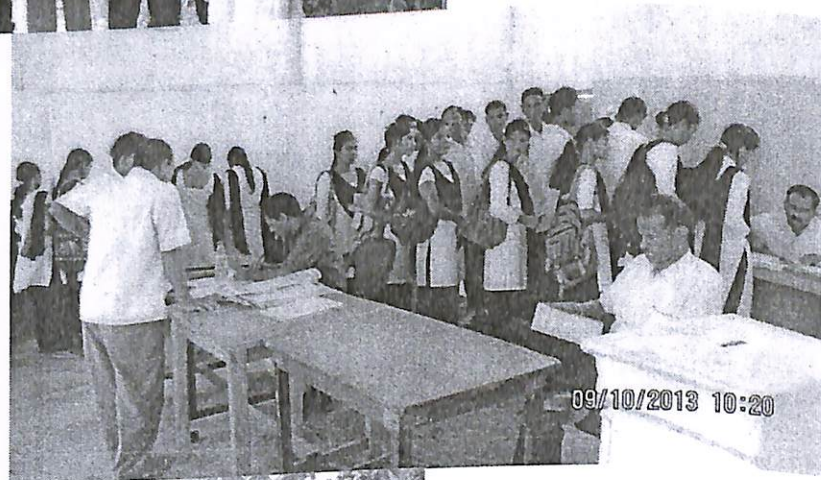

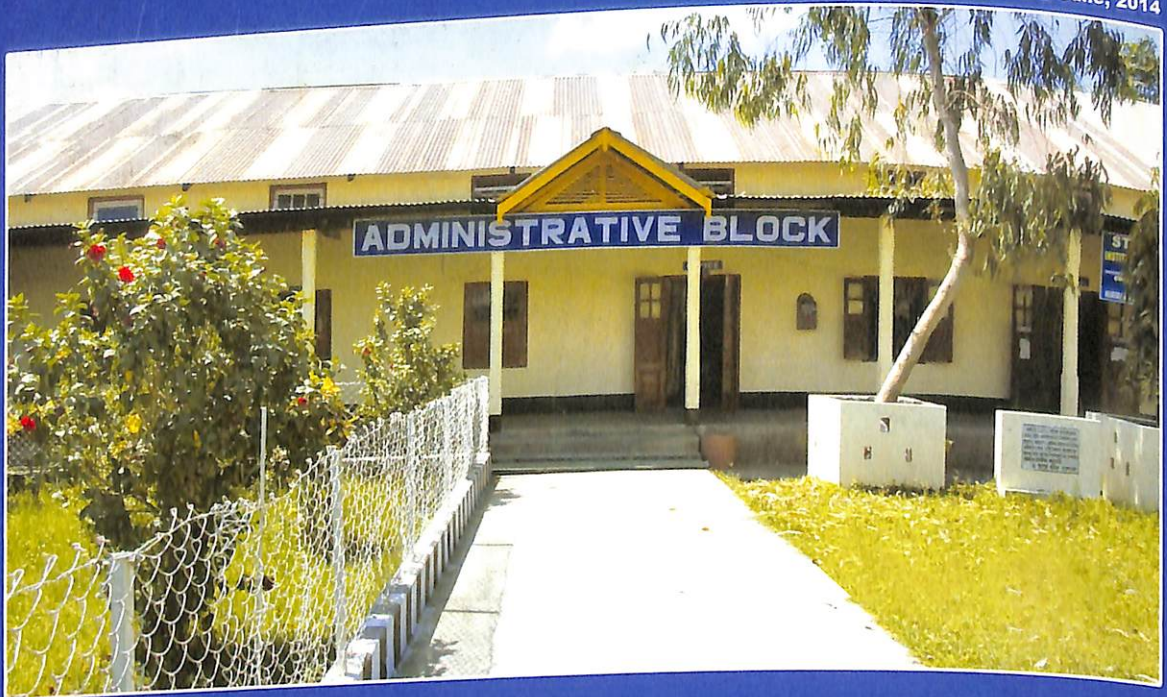
